WHAT IT COVERS

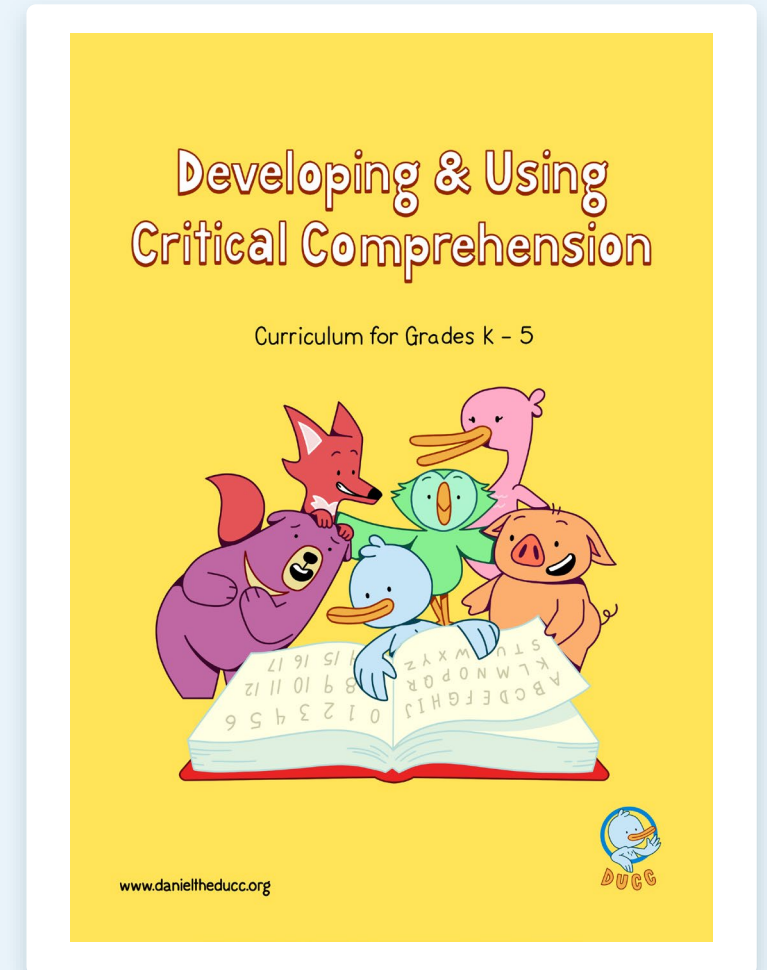
- An overview of the 24 lessons across 6 grades that teach digital literacy with a bedrock of critical thinking and social-emotional learning

WHAT IT COVERS

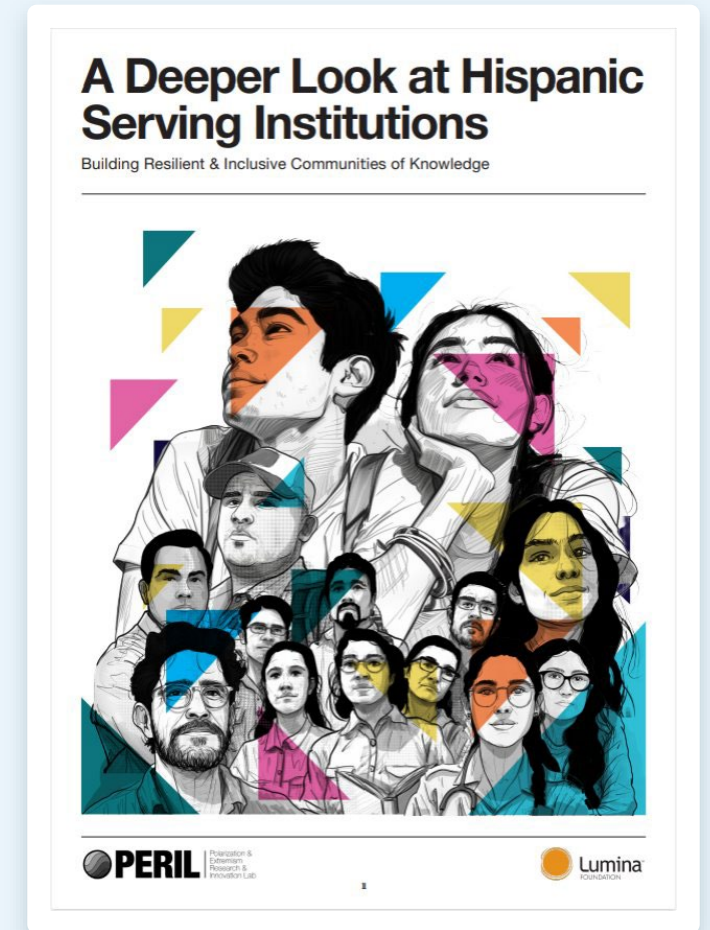
- Understand how extremism affects Hispanic/Latinx students, faculty, and staff
